



The Sandwatch International Database Terms of Use

The Sandwatch International Database has been developed by Dr David Gray, Canada; the Sandwatch Foundation; and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO). Throughout this document, the word “Developers” refers to the three entities listed above. The Sandwatch International Database is currently hosted by BrightSolid Online Technology Ltd. These Terms of Use were created to communicate certain rules and procedures for users of the Sandwatch International Database. These Terms of Use may be updated or changed at any time.

1. USERS

- Anyone may browse the Sandwatch International Database as a **Guest**.
- Persons directly involved in Sandwatch may browse and use the Sandwatch International Database as a **Sandwatch Member**.
- In order to browse the Sandwatch International Database as a **Guest** send a request to sandwatchdatabase@gmail.com
- In order to become a **Sandwatch Member** you must send a request to sandwatchdatabase@gmail.com and agree to provide true, accurate information, such as name, address, contact telephone and email. If it is believed or suspected that your information is untrue or inaccurate then you may be denied access to the database or your access may be terminated.
- After registration, a **Sandwatch Member** will be provided with a login and password to access and use the Sandwatch International Database. It is the responsibility of the **Sandwatch Member** to maintain the confidentiality of your login and password. As a registered **Sandwatch Member** you understand that you are responsible for all activities that occur under your account.

2. OWNERSHIP

- **Sandwatch Members** who access the Sandwatch International Database and upload their data and/or photos are the sole owners of those data and photos. **Sandwatch Members** understand that all materials uploaded, posted or transmitted to the Sandwatch International Database are their responsibility.
- Use of third party software required in order to use the Sandwatch International Database is governed by such third parties' licenses and not by these terms of use. An example of third party software is the use of Adobe Acrobat to read PDF copies of the tutorials.
